Order Form Instructions:

1. Be sure to fill in both sides of the form. Be sure your name and contact information are completely filled in.
2. Orders are met on a first-come, first-served basis. Please indicate on the order form the quantity of Produce, Broilers, Eggs, Pork, or Beef you wish to pick up for any given date. We work hard to accommodate your order and will contact you if there are any problems.
3. Please return this form as soon as possible to reserve your order. (By **May 15th** is preferred.)
4. If you are combining orders with another family, please only list one name as the contact and payment person. (We'll let you decide how to divvy up the total bill!) One person should pick up the complete order and divide it amongst the various families later. (You may do the order distribution at our facility.)
5. Order forms and payment may be mailed or personally delivered to Miller's Orchards (address above).
6. Cash or checks only for deposits and final payments. Please make checks payable to **Miller's Orchards Farm Market. Credit cards not accepted for subscription discounts; Cash only please.**
7. Deposit Reminder: Pork (\$100/order), Beef (\$250/order), Egg Subscription (\$25/subscription), Produce (\$100/\$240/\$375/\$800) and 100+ Broiler orders (\$100/subscription) require a deposit. Please pay all deposits when you turn in your form.
8. For 2015, we are offering several "bulk purchase" price levels for our Broilers. To qualify for bulk purchase, you must order at least 25 Broilers across all 2015 dressing dates.

We appreciate your cooperation in ordering ahead! We know the ordering process (pre-orders and possible deposits) is different than the ease of the supermarket. Of course, when was the last time the supermarket hand-raised pastured poultry, eggs, pork, and beef **just for you?** This process helps us ensure your items are fresh and ready on the pick-up date.

Keep a copy of your orders and dressing dates by filling in the chart below and hang it on your refrigerator. We will email reminders of upcoming pick-up dates.

Any Broilers not picked up at that time will revert to retail market prices **unless an alternate pick-up time has been pre-arranged**. Our regular whole bird price is for a fresh Broiler. Prompt pick-up ensures freshness and efficiency. Feel free to bring your cooler to haul your fresh birds home! For further questions, call Amber: 570-687-1288.

Pork and Beef pick-up times will be pre-arranged with each customer.

Egg pick-up times are during our Farm Market's regular retail hours.

To receive the subscription discounts, you must pay in cash.

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All the information you need to order the food you love

Defining our Products:

Pasture-Grazed: Our Pasture-grazed or “Pastured” animals will be raised in much the same way we have been raising our animals for the last ten years. They enjoy lush, grassy fields and are moved to fresh paddock routinely. They are essential for mowing, plowing, and fertilizing large stretches of land enabling us to grow acres of field crops, like rye and corn. Our Pasture-grazed animals are always fed Non-GMO grains along with the plants, grasses, and forbs in their pasture.

Discounts:

You receive discounts on our food by buying in bulk or committing to what we call **Subscriptions**. We realize that planning a year’s supply of food for your family in advance is challenging and goes against the norm. So we are more than happy to help customers who are willing to commit to purchasing food from our farm! We have pork, beef, chicken, egg, and produce subscriptions available this year. When looking at the order form, you can see the price breakdown for each subscription based on the quantity of food to which you commit. Keep in mind that you can combine orders with other customers, we simply ask for one customer to be the contact person in charge of pick-ups, payment, and divvying up the orders.

CSA Subscriptions:

Our CSA operates a bit differently than the traditional model. These CSA Subscriptions are much like a CSA in that you are able to support your farmers upfront financially, commit to buying our produce, and enjoy delicious fruits and vegetables throughout the season. It is different in the fact that you are never stuck with a box of predetermined veggies and fruits that you may not even like! We want to give you the options and freedom to choose what you would like to eat. So basically you will select about how much you would like to put on your Miller’s Orchards Gift Card and then you can use your gift card for our entire growing season.

Check out the details:

- Our subscriptions are available in 4 different values, giving you 10% off all of our produce. Just pick the option that best meets your needs. Remember these subscriptions are available first come, first serve.
 - The \$200 Sampler Subscription (\$220 value) Feeds Individuals/Light Eaters
 - The \$475 Small Family Subscription (\$525 value) Feeds 3+ people
 - The \$750 Large Family Subscription (\$825 value) Feeds 4+ people
 - The \$1600 Full Larder Subscription (\$1775 value) Feeds 5+ people
(Last year our family of 5 consumed about 20 bushels of apples, 10 bushels of potatoes, and 5 bushels of onions just to name a few. We do a lot of canning and freezing. If this sounds like your family, then a Full Larder Subscription is for you!)
- Our season will begin in May with an increasing amount and variety of produce available through late fall/early winter. We will endeavor to have winter crops and apples available until March of the following year.
- This is only for fresh produce (nothing canned or frozen).
- You can shop for produce **anytime** during store hours and choose only the produce you **love**.

Check out the perks:

- Take a break while on vacation and purchase extra when company comes, no forced pick-ups!
- Use it for your bulk canning purchases and U-picks too.
- Receive exclusive email updates give you the first chance at our produce.

This list is what we are planning to have this year, with the intent of having many more produce items available if possible.

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Frequently Asked Questions

How is the chicken, pork, and beef packaged?

- Our chickens are available whole or cut-up (2 breasts, 2 tenders, 2 wings, 2 quarters, 1 back). Your chicken is fresh, never frozen, on pick-up day. We are vacuum packing our chickens this year, which ensures that your delicious meat will last longer and taste even better.
- Our pork and beef are either vacuum packed or wrapped in butcher paper, depending on your preference. All of our pork and beef are only available frozen.

How is the beef raised?

The beef we are receiving from Green Grove Acres is 100% Pasture-Grazed or Grass-Fed. They are never fed grains as part of their diet. They are rotationally grazed, moving to fresh paddocks throughout the spring, summer, and fall. In the winter, they receive hay bales.

How much do your chickens, pigs, and beef weigh?

Most of our new customers have no idea what to expect when ordering chickens, pigs, or beef right from their farmer. So, we want to give you an idea of the size of the animals/how much meat you will be receiving in your orders. Because our animals are not force-fed, they all grow at different rates and will consequently vary in size.

- Our chickens range from 3.5-5.5lbs. Generally we part-out the larger chickens ensuring plump breasts and tenders. So if you are pricing out your order, you can **estimate** whole chickens at about 4.5lbs and parted-out chickens at about 5lbs. each. Please remember that our chicken's weight fluctuates, so this is only an approximation.
- Our goal is to raise our pigs to about 250-350lbs. The hanging weight, or the amount that you pay on per lb, will then be about 150-225lbs. for a whole hog. When ordering a whole or half hog, you will choose exactly what you would like, i.e. lots of pork chops or all breakfast sausage. We will walk you through the order, so don't worry about trying to talk shoulder roasts vs. hams with butchers...we will handle that for you! Pork boxes are roughly a quarter hog, but size varies as we determine what will go in each box.
- Because steers are such large animals, they take around 2 years to raise. The time it takes to raise them also means that their weight is harder to predict. For budgeting purposes, we typically approximate that by the time the steers go to butcher they will weigh around 1,000lbs. The hanging weight, or the amount that you pay on per lb, will then be about 500-600lbs for a whole steer. Please remember that this is an approximation! Weight will vary from steer to steer.

When will I receive my pork and beef?

Pork is available on a first come, first serve basis. We will put your name on our list and let you know whether to anticipate a spring pig or fall pig.

Beef is also available on a first come, first serve basis. We will put your name on our list and let you know when your beef should be available.

What happens to my deposit?

It is directly applied to your order at pick-up. Egg subscription deposits are applied in December.
